## LOCATION

The Bahamas is a cluster of islands in the North Atlantic. It spans over an area of 5,358 sq miles. The Bahamas has Cuba, Dominican Republic and Haiti (Hispaniola) to its south-west, the Turks and Caicos Islands to the north-west and has a total coastline of 2,200 miles.

## SIZE

The total area of the Bahamas is 5,358 square miles. Its geographic coordinates are 25 05N, 77 21W

## CAPITAL

Nassau is the capital of the Bahamas. It lies on the island of New Providence, with neighbouring Paradise Island accessible via Nassau Harbour bridges. A popular cruise-ship stop, the city has a hilly landscape and is known for beaches as well as its offshore coral reefs, popular for diving and snorkelling. It retains many of its typical pastel-coloured British colonial buildings, like the pink-hued Government House.

## CLIMATE

The climate is pleasantly subtropical, with an average winter temperature of 23°C (73°F) and an average summer temperature of 27°C (81°F). Rainfall averages 127 cm (50 in) and there are occasional hurricanes.
